Some top tips from the Judging panel

- Start early – writing a successful award entry is time consuming
- Follow the rules, they are clearly laid out
- Read the criteria carefully and ensure you have covered them all – these are the first things we look for when judging
- Every sentence must be meaningful and add value, think to yourself “so what?”
- Your submission should not just explain what you did – but demonstrate how you went above and beyond - and what the benefits of this have been to your organisation or client
- Add the Wow factor in, if applicable

More top tips from the Judging panel



- Use a case study / project to highlight your entry
- Include 3 attributed testimonials to support your application
- Back up each claim with demonstrable evidence or stats – can you prove it?
- If working with a partner or client who played a vital role in your submission name them and do a joint entry
- If an award refers to any MRS Codes, Standards, Guidelines etc. include these in your submission
- Check the grammar and spelling
- Get a fresh pair of eyes to review the submission before you send it

Things to avoid!



- Don't miss the deadline – the rules are clearly laid out in the online entry
- Do not exceed the maximum word count of 500 for the main submission
- Don't just reproduce your marketing credentials /website material
- Don't turn your client supporting statement into part of the main submission
- Don't waffle and waste your words, be relevant you only have 500 words
